Dear Parents,

Hello and warm greetings! As we embark on the exciting journey of a new school year, we wanted to kindly bring your attention to some important information:

1. Class Schedule and Arrangements:

(a) During the school opening week, from 1 September 2023 to 8 September 2023, classes will be conducted from 08:05 to 13:00. On 5 September 2023, classes will follow the regular timetable, and no lunch will be provided throughout the school opening week.

(b) From 11 September 2023, classes will be held from 08:05 to 15:45. Please refer to your class timetable for more information.

2. Lunch Policy

Our school policy requires junior form students to have lunch at school on regular school days. The details of the policy are as follows:

(a) Targets: S.1 to S.3 students.

(b) Objectives:

- Foster a stronger sense of belonging
- Promote better communication between students and teachers
- Cultivate self-discipline
- Encourage the development of healthy eating habits

(c) Approach:

- To promote healthy lunch habits, students have the option to either order meals from the school tuck shop, bring their own lunch boxes, or have their parents bring lunch to school. Microwaves are provided for students to heat up their own packed meals.
- The menu for September and payment receipts will be distributed on 1 September 2023. Each lunch costs HKD \$36, and there will be three daily options, including halal and vegetarian choices. The school tuck shop will deliver the lunch boxes to the classrooms, where they will be distributed by the class teachers.

3. Student's Personal Records

The school requires students' personal records to ensure the provision of appropriate care and support. Parents' personal information is optional. Kindly assist your child in completing the attached form and submit it by 4 September 2023.

(a) Purpose of data collection: The school will collect your child's information solely for health and safety management purposes. All collected data will be treated as strictly confidential and for internal use only. Providing personal data is optional, but insufficient information may hinder the school's ability to assist your child in case of emergencies.

(b) Personal information request: According to the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, you have the right to review and amend your personal information. Please contact the school if necessary.

4. Student Health and Emergency Room Fees Consent Form

To create a healthy campus, please remind your children to maintain healthy eating and lifestyle habits, adhere to regular schedules, and ensure personal, household, and school cleanliness. In case of respiratory symptoms like fever, cough, or sore throat, prompt medical attention should be sought, and children should stay home as advised by the doctor.

Additionally, as government hospitals charge a \$180 service fee for urgent medical cases, parents are requested to sign a consent form allowing the school to arrange emergency medical treatment at the Accident & Emergency (A&E) to prevent any treatment delays. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

5. Intellectual Property, and the Publication of Student Works and Photos

To promote respect for intellectual property rights among students, parents are kindly requested to remind their children not to plagiarize the work of other students, publications, online sources, or any works not created by themselves. If any instances of plagiarism are discovered, they will be treated as incomplete assignments, and the student's scores for assignments or exams may be deducted accordingly. If your child needs to quote the work of other authors, please include proper citations to acknowledge the original creators' copyrights.

In order to recognize students' achievements, our school may showcase students' photos and works in school publications, promotional materials, campus displays, or on the school website. Outstanding works may also be selected for participation in public competitions. We kindly request parents to sign the consent form to allow their child's work to participate in public competitions.

6. Use of students' portrait rights

In the course of student's involvement in various school activities, it is possible that our school will capture photographs or record videos. Consequently, these visual materials may be publicly showcased or published on the school's official website. With utmost regard for safeguarding students' personal information and privacy, any collected photographs or videos of students and their parents will be exclusively utilized for non-commercial purposes such as educational communication and promotion within the school community. As such, the school cordially seeks parental consent for the inclusion of their child's likeness in the aforementioned educational activities, promotional materials, and publicity efforts.

7. Tropical cyclones and heavy rain warnings

To ensure students' safety during the occurrence of tropical cyclones and heavy rain warnings, parents are advised to take note of the following arrangements:

- (a) If a typhoon signal of 8 or above, or a red or black rainstorm warning is in effect before school starts and the Education Bureau has announced class suspension, students do not need to return to school on that day.
- (b) If the Education Bureau issues a class suspension notice during school hours, the school will continue with regular classes until it is deemed safe to suspend classes. In such cases:
 - (i) Parents are not required to come to the school and pick up their children in heavy rain and strong winds if the school has not announced the class suspension. It is safest for students to remain on campus. If the situation is safe, the school will allow students to leave on their own, and parents do not need to come to the school to pick up their children.
 - (ii) If the school decides to dismiss students early during school hours, notifications will be sent to parents through the school's website and registered mobile phone numbers. Please pay attention to these notifications.
- (c) When a red or black rainstorm warning is issued during school hours, the school will handle the situation as follows:
 - (i) The school will not dismiss students early. Students will remain on campus until regular dismissal time, and classes will continue as usual. The decision to allow students to leave will be made based on the prevailing conditions at dismissal time.
 - (ii) Unless there are exceptional circumstances, the school discourages parents from picking up their children without an official announcement of class suspension. Such actions pose a threat to parental safety under extreme weather and disrupt students' normal learning.
 - (iii) If a red or black rainstorm warning is issued, the school will notify parents through the school's website and registered mobile phone numbers regarding whether students will be dismissed as usual at the regular dismissal time.
 - (iv) If conditions permit, the school will allow students to have lunch outside of school. However, if it is deemed unsafe for students to go out for meals, the school will make special arrangements for orderly food purchases to alleviate hunger. The school will extend the lunch break to provide sufficient time for students to buy food, and class teachers will supervise students in the classrooms. The school's food service will offer sufficient and basic food options such as bread, lunch boxes, rice noodles, and noodles. Given the unique circumstances, parents should understand that while the taste and variety of the food may not be optimal, the school has implemented the most feasible measures based on the safety considerations of all students. The school will not allow students to order takeaway food to maintain fairness and prevent potential disruptions caused by delayed deliveries during inclement weather.

- (v) Some students have expressed difficulties in purchasing food at the school's food service due to a lack of money. Therefore, even if students have lunch at home, the school recommends that parents provide a small amount of pocket money daily for students' emergency needs, as secondary school students require pocket money for unforeseen circumstances, similar to the situation mentioned above.
- (vi) However, if a student does not have immediate access to money, parents should encourage the student to seek assistance from teachers. The teachers will make every effort to help students by offering options such as lending money for food purchases or providing biscuits to alleviate hunger.

The school prioritizes the safety of all students and will implement various contingency measures accordingly. While it is not possible to cover all emergency situations, safety remains the primary concern. 8. Student Activities Support Grant

The Student Activities Support Grant aims to provide financial assistance to students for their life-wide learning activities, including local or overseas excursions, project learning, training courses, participation in uniformed groups, community services, and sports activities, among others.


Parents have the opportunity to apply for a partial or full exemption of fees for life-wide learning activities, with a maximum subsidy of \$1,000 per year, if their children meet the following requirements:

- (a) Students who are currently receiving a full subsidy.
- (b) Students who have been granted comprehensive social security assistance (CSSA).
- (c) Students who are facing special economic needs.

For parents whose children do not meet the above requirements, they may still apply for a discretionary subsidy of up to \$800 per year by following these procedures:

- (i) Submit a parent's letter clearly stating the following information:
 - Name of the activity
 - Title of the Subsidy
 - Date of the application.
- (ii) The letter should be submitted to the general office through the class teacher.
- (iii) The school will exercise its discretionary power to determine the partial exemption of fees for life-wide learning activities based on the following criteria:
 - Any siblings receiving a half-subsidy
 - The number of siblings attending the school
 - Special situations, such as parents being unemployed.
 - Other relevant factors.

2. 留校午膳安排

「留校午膳」是本校對初中同學的一貫政策，本年度是項政策的實施詳情如下：

(a) 對象：中一至中三級學生。

(b) 目標：

- 加強學生對學校的認識及歸屬感；
- 增進學生與老師之間的溝通；
- 培養學生的自治能力；
- 培養學生有健康的午膳習慣。
-

(c) 方法：

- 為鼓勵同學養成良好的午膳習慣，同學需向食物部訂飯、學生自攜飯盒或由家長帶午飯到校，學校亦安排微波爐，學生可自行翻熱自攜飯盒。
- 9月份的飯單和付款回條將於9月1日派發，每個午餐費用為港幣\$36，每天有3款午餐(包括清真及素食款式)供學生及家長選購。食物部將午膳飯盒送至班房，再由班主任分發。

3. 填寫學生個人紀錄

本校需收集學生的個人紀錄(家長個人資料可選填)，以便為學生提供最適當的照顧。請家長協助 貴子弟填寫附件並於 9 月 4 日交回予班主任。

- (a) 收集目的：本校收集 貴子弟的個人資料，只會用作處理有關學生的保健及安全事宜。收集所得的信息將嚴格保密，僅供內部使用。雖然提供個人資料與否純屬自願，但若你所提供資料不足，本校可能無法掌握 貴子弟的病歷，當意外發生時，我們可能未能為貴子弟提供適切的協助。
- (b) 索閱個人資料：根據《個人資料(私隱)條例》，你有權要求索閱和修訂你所提供的資料。如有需要，請與學校聯絡。

4. 學生健康及急症室收費事宜與同意書

為建立一個健康校園，請家長敦促子弟注意遵守健康的飲食及生活習慣，作息有時，並保持個人、家居及學校的衛生清潔。若出現發熱、咳嗽、喉痛等上呼吸道感染病徵，應盡早求醫，並按照醫生建議留在家中休息。

此外，鑒於政府醫院會就急病求診個案收取每次\$180 的服務費，現懇請家長簽署同意書，讓學校在緊急情況下可安排子弟到急症室求醫，以免耽誤治療時間，尚希垂注為感！

5. 知識產權及學生作品與相片之刊載

為使同學學習保護知識產權，懇請家長敦促子弟切勿抄襲其他同學、書報、網上或所有非本人創作之作品，如有發現，學生可視為欠交功課處理，而其功課或測驗考試所得分數亦將被扣除。若貴子弟需引錄其他作者之作品，請列明有關出處，以示尊重原創者之版權。

本校為肯定同學的成果，會於學校刊物、宣傳品、校園擺設或校網等途徑展示同學的照片及作品，並會選取優秀作品參與公開比賽。懇請家長簽署同意書，讓貴子弟的作品得以參加公開比賽。

6. 有關「使用學生肖像權」事宜

本校學生在參與本校各項活動時，校方可能會拍攝照片或錄影。因此，所有學生活動的相片及錄影，均有機會向公眾展示或上載學校網頁。為保障學生的個人資料及私隱，本校對所收集及儲存的學生及其家長的相片或錄影，只會用於本校教學交流及推廣等非商業用途上。為此本校特函徵詢，望家長同意貴子弟的肖像出現在上述各項教育活動、宣傳及推廣上。

7. 熱帶氣旋及暴雨警告訊號生效時學校之應變措施

為讓學生得以在安全的環境下學習，請家長注意下列有關熱帶氣旋及暴雨警告生效時之安排：

- (a) 若八號或以上颱風訊號、紅色或黑色暴雨警告於上課前已生效，教育局已宣佈停課時，同學於該天則不用回校上課。
- (b) 若教育局於上課時間內發出停課通知，學校會照常上課，在安全情況下，學校才會宣佈停課，讓學生自行回家。因此，
- (i) 家長不需冒着大風暴雨到校接回子女，因為學校沒有宣佈停課，子女留校實為最安全的安排；若情況安全，學校會讓學生自行離開學校，家長無需到校接回子女。
 - (ii) 若學校決定於上課期間提早放學，則會於學校網頁及已登記家長之手機短訊中向家長發放消息，請家長留意。
- (c) 凡於上課時間內發出紅色及黑色暴雨警告時，學校將作下列方式處理：
- (i) 學校不會提早放學，學生會留校至下午放學時間，上課如常進行，至放學時間再視乎當時情況是否合適，學校才決定會否讓學生離開。
 - (ii) 除非有非常特殊理由，並有法定監護人到校，學校極不鼓勵家長在學校沒有宣佈停課時接走子女，此舉一來對家長自身的安危構成威脅，二者會嚴重影響學生的正常學習，懇請家長垂注。
 - (iii) 紅色及黑色暴雨警告發出時，學生會否如常於下午放學時間放學，學校會因應安全情況於學校網頁及已登記之家長手機短訊中向家長發放消息，請家長留意。
 - (iv) 若情況許可，學校會讓學生出外午膳，惟若學校認為學生出外用膳安全會受威脅時，學校會作特別安排，讓學生有秩序地到食物部購買食物充饑。學校會提早午膳時間，讓學生有足夠時間購買食物，而班主任亦會到課室照顧同學；食物部會提供足夠及基本的充饑食物，如麵包、飯盒或米粉、麵類等。鑒於情況特殊，家長須明白縱使食物味道不夠好，種類不夠多，但基於全校學生的安全考慮，這是一個本校所能安排的最可行措施。學校不會讓學生自行訂購外賣，因此舉會造成不公平及混亂，更可能因天雨關係而外賣不能於短時間送到，以致延誤上課時間。
 - (v) 有同學表示因沒有帶錢回校而未能到本校食物部購買食物，現請家長留意，縱使學生回家吃飯，本校建議家長能每日給予少量零用錢作學生應急之用，畢竟中學生需要零用錢傍身，以應付突發需要，就如上述的情況一般。
 - (vi) 不過，若同學即時未有金錢在身，請家長督請學生向老師提出請求，本校老師定當竭力幫助學生，解決基本充饑的需要，例如先借出金錢讓學生購買食物，或私下拿出餅乾讓學生充饑等。

學校一定會以全體學生的安全為最大考慮原則，作出不同的應變措施；緊急情況不能盡錄，但安全是首要原則，懇請家長與學校通力合作，並囑咐 貴子弟遵守校方及老師當下的指示。家長有任何疑問或意見，歡迎致電 2441 3818 與梁偉康副校長聯絡。

8. 學生活動支援津貼

學生活動支援津貼資助中一至中六學生參與全方位學習活動之費用，例如境內或境外參觀考察、專題研習、訓練課程、制服團隊、社會服務、體藝活動等。

學生如符合下列資格者，家長可向校方申請學生活動支援津貼，豁免部份或全部參與全方位學習活動所須費用，全學年上限為\$1,000。

- (a) 領取學生全額資助的學生
- (b) 領取綜合社會保障援助的學生
- (c) 其他有特殊經濟需要的學生
